JUSTIN SUH (-7)

Q. Just overall, obviously low scores are out there today, you got one of them. What went well?

JUSTIN SUH: Off the tee I felt like I kept it in play. Compared to last week, I felt like I drove it a little bit better. Even my shots into the greens, I felt like we didn't attack too many pins aggressively, I felt like our lines were fairly conservative, but I felt we were just leaving ourselves good chances at birdies.

Most of these par 5s are downwind today so you had to take advantage of that, and to just have -- I think I only made -- most of my birdies were under five feet just from the par 5s, kind of tap-ins. So I think to give yourself birdie opportunities like that and keep the round going is pretty big.

Q. Just with Playoffs kind of on the horizon, you're someone who's kind of closely on that bubble, a top 70, and how much are you considering that when you're thinking of events you may play or just even kind of round to round as you try to get there and make a push?

JUSTIN SUH: Yeah, I think my schedule is kind of up in the air because as of right now I'm not officially in The Open, so it makes going to Scottish a little bit difficult when I can stay in the States, maybe play a couple events here with the John Deere and Barracuda.

We've given it some thought this week, but I feel like I don't really do well if I look into the future, so I'm just focused on this tournament and try to do my best this week.

Q. It's been kind of -- you've had some solid finishes this year kind of performing at different spots. Overall at this point in the season are you pleased with where you're at?

JUSTIN SUH: Somewhat. I feel like I put myself in some good positions but didn't finish too great. I wouldn't say pleased. I would say I learned a lot, which in this game you take a few lessons from each tournament. I feel like being in those positions, I've left learning a piece of myself and how to attack those situations a little bit better.

Yeah, I'd say I'm pretty satisfied. I usually just kind of look at my game and see where it's at. If my game's feeling good, then I'm pretty satisfied.



Q. Of those five birdies in a row, is there one that sticks out?

JUSTIN SUH: Not really. I'd say started with the par 5 just making a good up-and-down, kind of had a tap-in. I'd say most of those were pretty like solid birdies. I guess the one on 16 isn't the one where most people would make a birdie on that hole, it's playing pretty long. I just hit good shots, gave myself good looks and made the putt.

Q. Did you hit it tight mostly or did you make some long putts?

JUSTIN SUH: I hit it pretty tight on that stretch. I think the longest putt I made was on 18, which I think they said was 27 feet, but before that the first four were pretty short putts.

Q. What do you think of golf here in Detroit and seeing the crowds come out like this on day one of this tournament?

JUSTIN SUH: It's awesome. I think it helps grow the game. I feel like there's been a lot of people coming out the last couple days. We did a little outing on the side of 17 with the little basketball shot. To see a lot of the kids from The First Tee of Detroit come out, get to experience a little bit of golf and basketball, it was cool to see.

Q. Fun for you, too?

JUSTIN SUH: Fun for me, too. I got to shoot some hoops, it was nice.
