TAYLOR PENDRITH (-13)

Q. Obviously put yourself in a good spot over two days. Just kind of assess your round today.

TAYLOR PENDRITH: Yeah, I played very solid, no bogeys again today, which was great. Hit a lot of really good wedge shots on my front nine. Back nine was a little bit more of a grind, but putter kept me in it, made some nice putts on 3 and 4 and then kind of scrambled around the last hour out there, but all in all, yeah, super happy and excited for the weekend.

Q. You've been around these spots before, you're going to go into the final round [sic] co-lead. Just what have you learned from some of those experiences that you hope to put into practice these next two days?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: Obviously I played well here last year, so it's exciting to be playing well again this year. Learned a lot from last year, got to play aggressive, stay aggressive. The course is starting to firm up a little bit, but there's still tons of birdies out there, so just yeah, stay aggressive and keep making birdies.

Q. What is it about your game and this course that has seemingly matched up so well?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: I don't know. I think it's a combination of this is the same type of grass I grew up on, same type of greens, old-school layout, a lot of drivers. Yeah, I don't know, I really like this place and feel good with everything.

Q. You said last year maybe not as aggressive mindset-wise on Sunday. How much does that differ from what you would maybe normally do in a tournament on the weekend where you know you're probably going to get to 25 under?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: Yeah, I mean, the years I played on the Korn Ferry Tour, every week you had to shoot 20, 25 under. I feel like that's I guess prepared me in a way, but you've just got to -- especially out here, there's a lot of wedges. Four par 5s that we're mostly playing downwind both days, haven't done a very good job on them, I think I've gotten three out of eight. If I can take care of those tomorrow, hit my wedges good and maybe roll some putts in, we'll see.

Q. When's the last time you made a bogey?



TAYLOR PENDRITH: I don't know. Not this week. I came close a couple times today, but I had a nice putt on the last to bail me out.

Q. Do you think a lot of Canada will be crossing the border when they see you at the top of the leaderboard?
