Q. Dylan, great round today. Can you talk a little bit about it?

DYLAN WU: Yeah. I mean, coming off yesterday I knew the course was going to be pretty scorable today. I was pretty excited to come out this morning because it was less wind, fresh greens. Kind of a little bit of a rollercoaster round two. Finished decently well to shoot 3 under par, I feel like there's still a lot of birdies out there. Felt like I did a good job of scoring. Not necessarily feeling great about my game off the tee at least, but I managed to grind when I kind of hit it in the trees in the rough and then made birdies on the holes I hit it in the fairway, so that was a good part to scoring today especially when the scores are going to be low.

Overall happy with the way I grinded today, just hoping to hopefully hit a few more fairways on the weekend and yeah, should put me in a good spot on Sunday if I do that.

Q. Three under on the par 3s today. What was working so well for you on those holes?

DYLAN WU: Yeah, I just feel like even yesterday my irons have felt great. Feel like if I just put myself in the fairway I was going to have a birdie look. For some reason some of the par 3s, I just felt pretty good about it.

I stole a birdie on hole 9 today, chipped in from long left. I kind of just barely missed the shot and I knew long left there was OK. Luckily the chip went in.

But the other two par 3s were good numbers and you can kind of attack when you have 9 irons in there, so luckily hit good shots. But this course is not very long and it's pretty warm out here, so if you hit all the fairways you have a lot of short clubs.

So the biggest thing for me is just hit a lot of fairways this weekend and I feel like if I do that I'll have a good chance of putting myself in position on Sunday.

Q. You talked about the rollercoaster round, I assume you're alluding to the back nine a little bit. Can you talk about what you're going to do today to ensure a good round tomorrow as well as Sunday?

DYLAN WU: Yeah. At the end I just wasn't really hitting the driver great the first two days, even through it a little bit for some reason, and it's weird because those two have been



pretty solid all year. At the end of the round I was just shaping shots and doing whatever I could just to get the ball in the fairway, and that's honestly a big thing. Just waiting to have irons.

Yeah, just going to probably eat some lunch right now and kind of reset and just try to have a good range session, just try to imagine the holes on the course and try to make sure I'm ready for Saturday and Sunday for the first tee shot tomorrow. So yeah, the biggest thing out here is just hitting a lot of fairways and if you do that, you can make a lot of birdies.
