ADAM LONG (-11)

Q. Adam, 5 under par today, nice round, if we can get some comments on your play.

ADAM LONG: Yeah, I played nice. I was happy to have minimal neck pain today compared to yesterday. It was kind of more of a dull pain that I can play through, but it wasn't the sharp pain that I had yesterday. Yeah, I played well. A few mistakes here and there, but made a lot of birdies.

Q. Including one on the first hole, you had bogey there. So how important was it to just keep positive there?

ADAM LONG: Yeah, it was frustrating. I hit two good shots into the green and then left a putt way short, missed a putt and there we go, 1 over quickly, but made some birdies to get them back.

Q. Any of those birdies really stand out today?

ADAM LONG: Not a whole lot, just some wedges that were nice and some good putts, but I don't think anything was out of the ordinary.

Q. Tied for the lead right now, probably not at the end of the day but still in really good shape going into the weekend. Just what is your mindset?

ADAM LONG: Yeah, just going up against some of the best players in the world here, so going to have to keep the pedal down, make a lot of birdies and keep attacking.

Q. Possible weather coming in tomorrow, how will this golf course play different?

ADAM LONG: Yeah, if it gets even softer than it is, I mean, the fairways are firm right now so that could make it play a little longer. And then controlling your spin when the greens get soft, you can start ripping some wedges back. There are plenty of wedges here, so controlling the spin into the greens might be key.

Q. And you mentioned your neck. Is it literally just sort of day to day for you and what's the key to staying healthy this week?

ADAM LONG: I think so, yeah. They're trying to say stay off of it as much as I want to like dig in there and kind of loosen things up, I think I need to just let things calm down on its own, put some heat on it and a little bit of therapy.



Q. So I'm guessing you won't be going to the driving range this afternoon?

ADAM LONG: It's hard for me not to. I might hit a few wedges, but I'll keep it light.
