With that pin you've got the backstop, I knew that was a chance. So I knew I had some chances coming in, I just had to execute and finally did it. It was pretty sloppy early on and off to a slow start and got lapped as I should have and then managed to bring it back.

Q. Nice to be done with an early finish. How will you spend the afternoon?

LUCAS GLOVER: Get a little work done and then just do some recovery stuff in the room and talk to the fam and get some rest.

Q. And the players that are around you challenging, most of them are young. How much are you looking forward to tomorrow?
