HARRISON FRAZAR (-7)



Q. You were kind of within striking distance all day. How do you assess your play today?

HARRISON FRAZAR: I feel like I did OK. I would have liked to have driven it a little bit better off the tee. I feel like I hit some good iron shots, I hit some good putts. You know, I just ran with him for as long as I could. We made it 67 holes or whatever.

That putt he made on the par 3, he made about a 40-, 45-footer there, and then that wedge shot he hit on 16 was one of the best wedge shots I've ever seen. That was a one-two punch and the rest of us were out.

Q. For you, this is your best finish on the PGA TOUR Champions. What does that mean that you were able to put this together over these four days?

HARRISON FRAZAR: I think, like I told you earlier in the week, attitude was a big thing. It tells me that even though I did not have my very best stuff, with a better attitude I can do a lot better and be better. I know I belong out here, it's just a matter of time.

Q. You were talking yesterday about the, quote, unquote, brighter lights, the bigger galleries, being around Hall of Famers. You just said you belong. How much does that help the feeling of belonging and the furthering of that?

HARRISON FRAZAR: I mean, that's a hell of an experience, leading a major for that long, sleeping on it for a couple of nights. It was a great experience. And having all those people out there was fantastic. Watching Steve do what he does, and Stewart's a major champion, too. Playing with him for 36 holes, I've known these guys forever, but being in the battle with them showed me that I can do this.
