MAX GREYSERMAN (-14)

Q. All right, Max, another solid day. You'll be in the final group tomorrow. How are you feeling heading into Sunday?

MAX GREYSERMAN: Excited for the opportunity. I'm playing pretty solid, just keep doing what I'm doing and see how it plays tomorrow, but excited for a chance to win.

Q. Seems like your game's really -- you started off the year really well and then kind of picked it up as of late. How are you feeling about your form in general, especially since I guess fourth in Denver?

MAX GREYSERMAN: Yeah, finished second, had -- I mean, I wouldn't say I had a chance to win. I mean, I was hanging around the lead, but it felt like I was always two shots away. Hopefully I'll have a better opportunity tomorrow.

Been playing pretty solid all year except for a couple lulls here and there. Saw my coach this past weekend after a missed cut, a couple things we wanted to key on. Just putting it well like I usually do and just got to give myself looks and it will be a good day tomorrow. I'm excited to play with, I think it's John and --

MAX GREYSERMAN: -- Jake. I know those guys really well, two really good dudes, so it should be a fun day tomorrow.

Q. How's this course holding up? I know last few weeks have kind of been some higher cut lines, but this place seems to be challenging.

MAX GREYSERMAN: Yeah, this is the type of course where I enjoy playing more. Not as many wedges, not as soft, longer rough, longer course. I mean, more of a PGA TOUR-type of setup I would say. But good golf wins anywhere, so you've got to be able to play well on the short courses, too. I just enjoy this type of challenge a little more than like Salt Lake City, which is basically wedge on every hole.

Q. In Colorado after one of your rounds you said like life is good, I'm not stressing out, just kind of taking it day to day. How helpful is that especially on a day like today where you know you're going to be in the final group tomorrow?



MAX GREYSERMAN: Yeah, I mean, some people say don't look at leaderboards, some people look at leaderboards. I feel like some of the top players that are always around the lead that kind of play with that pressure all the time, so I don't mind looking at leaderboards and having that pressure.

Q. And then not to take the focus off of this week, but next week going up to New Jersey, how much are you looking forward to heading up?

MAX GREYSERMAN: Yeah, I circled that on my calendar at the start of the year. I'm happy to go playing well leading into that event, it's like a major. It will be nice. I'm staying at my grandparents' house, I have some family, my wife's flying up with our dog, so yeah, really looking forward to that. Focus on tomorrow first.
