That's kind of my process. Kind of did a really good job of that this afternoon, so I'm really proud of myself.

Q. How much fun is match play when you guys get to do it in the fall?

CHRISTO LAMPRECHT: Yeah, we don't get a lot of it in the fall, but it's really cool if we do. I think it brings out the best golf in players. Generally for myself, I play my best golf when I play match play. I enjoy part of it kind of playing against the person, all you've got to do is beat him. A lot of feistiness going on and I enjoy that part of the game.
