BRETT QUIGLEY (-10)



Q. Well, Brett, off to a great start, back-to-back 67s and just one bogey through 36 holes. With that said, if we can just kind of wrap up the past 36 holes.

BRETT QUIGLEY: Pretty nice playing golf. Actually, had a great day today playing with Jerry and Parel, so it was an easy round today. But playing nice, doing a lot of things well. Just know I've got to keep going, got to keep shooting low out here, but certainly pleased with the first two days.

Q. Brett, since the missed cut at the Senior PGA, you played pretty well, bunch of top-10s. Do you feel like you've been on the verge of a week like this so far?

BRETT QUIGLEY: I've been playing well. You try to get close to a lead, for sure I've done a lot of things well, you just don't know with scoring who's going to win, who's going to do what. Certainly being in the last group on Sunday is where we all try to be every week and looks like I'm going to be there this week, so I'm excited.

Q. First two days, what's been clicking the best for you? What are you doing well?

BRETT QUIGLEY: Just tidy up. I'm hitting it a little bit better than -- I had two weeks off and I was pretty sloppy coming here on Monday. Just with some practice started hitting a little better and my timing's a little better, so it's been fun to see the golf ball go where I'm looking.

Q. And if tomorrow is a continuation of the back nine today and you're going head to head with Jerry on this, I know you've got to worry about your own game, but what's it like going toe to toe with Jerry?

BRETT QUIGLEY: I love it. I love playing with Jerry and Scott, and we're all friendly out here. We're competitive as heck, but I couldn't ask for a better person to play with on Sunday. I know he's not going to give me anything and I know I'm going to have to play well to beat him.

Plus, there's still some guys close, so you never know, a guy could shoot 7 or 8 under. I know we've got to still keep the pedal down and try to maybe get to 15, 16.

Q. Last two groups in the afternoon, the back nine got pretty tough and looked like the only real birdie holes were the par 5s. Did the wind kick up a little bit? Did the course get a little bit firmer?

BRETT QUIGLEY: Wind, a little bit, and these greens are tough. It's a good, hard,

old-school Donald Ross golf course and if you're out of position it can bite you a little bit and sometimes it does. Even the par 5s, I had it close to the green in two both times and I had it out of position, the best I could do was about 15 feet on both my pitches. Need to tidy that up a little bit better.

Q. Bunker shot on 3?

BRETT QUIGLEY: The bunker shot on 3 was great. I hit it where I wanted to and hit a nice bunker shot to get that flag-high from maybe 30 yards, so that was a pretty good bunker shot and kind of continued the birdie, birdie, birdie start and get in the thick of it.
