STEPHAN JAEGER (-13)

Q. Stephan, good playing, nice solid round for you here at the Wyndham Championship. Just an opening comment on your round.

STEPHAN JAEGER: Honestly, I played solid. I bogeyed I think probably the two hardest holes on the golf course. Other than that, I really didn't make many mistakes. I hit a lot of fairways, wedged it close a couple times and made some nice putts. Definitely solid round for sure.

Q. Two different stretches of three birdies in a row. Can you just walk us through those holes?

STEPHAN JAEGER: Yeah. On the front I birdied I guess 7, 8, 9. Seven was a really nice 8-iron, I hit it to like five feet behind the hole, made a nice putt there. Then next two holes I hit wedges within six feet or seven feet and converted the putts.

Yeah, on the back nine you start out with the par 5 15. It's somewhat of an easy hole, nice drive and kind of left myself in a tough bunker shot, but once again, made about a six-footer.

Then hit a really nice 8-iron the next hole to about 10 feet up the hill, pretty easy putt right to left, made that one. Hit it close on 17.

So like I said, overall really solid day. Kept it kind of in front of me which is what you have to do out here, you have to hit a lot of fairways to be able to score. So yeah, I'm happy.

Q. And lastly, you put yourself in a position to contend for a title tomorrow. What's the mentality going into tomorrow's round depending on how far back you are?

STEPHAN JAEGER: Yeah, it's really easy honestly for me, I'm going to try my best on every shot. I've done a really good job this week kind of just taking the result as it is. You know, we're not always going to hit good shots even though we try. That's kind of been my approach this week. It's kind of put me in a really nice mental space, which is nice.

I'm happy with where I'm at. I haven't looked at the scoreboard, but we'll see where the leaders end up, but it's not going to change my game plan tomorrow for sure.
