# Q. PGA TOUR debut, had a great start. Just want to start off with some comments about Round 1?

**BILLY DAVIS:** Like you said, a good start. I had a really good group today. They were all nice to me so I felt pretty comfortable out there to begin with. Still have to play No. 9 tomorrow, but we're in a good spot.

**BILLY DAVIS:** It was a course right by my house and I played a pre-qualifier there before and I was kind of like, I don't know about this and my dad told me to do it. All right, whatever.

Got through the pre-qualifier and it was really good experience getting able to play with some Korn Ferry guys on Monday and just happened to play really well and have a good day.

**BILLY DAVIS:** I did, yeah. It was just one of those days where I played well and then it was just -- I was just supposed to make it that day, that's just how it was.

#### Q. What are your goals for this week?

**BILLY DAVIS:** I've learned a lot so far and that was the main one, just take away some good lessons from this. I want to compete and do well and make the cut and have a good finish. That's what my goal was so far this week.

**BILLY DAVIS:** Yeah, Jonathan Byrd. I know his son, Jackson Byrd, pretty well. We were on the Junior Ryder Cup team together, so I've seen him at a few of his tournaments. Tyson Alexander, his dad's the assistant coach at Auburn, so he came up and said a few words. Obviously Matt Kuchar, a few other guys told me good luck today, which is cool.
