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**Q. Playing in the final grouping, what are your thoughts after the third round?**

**CAMILO VILLEGAS:** Today was an interesting day, a little different than the first two. Putter wasn't as hot, but I think overall it was positive. I mean, I'm in the final group tomorrow, that's good. Emotionally I was pretty at peace on the golf course and made great birdies on No. 15 and 16, probably two of the holes that were playing the toughest. There's a lot of low scores on this golf course, see what happens.

**Q. After going low yesterday, it's always hard to kind of follow up with another low round. What kind of kept you at peace today?**

**CAMILO VILLEGAS:** I think not starting the way I wanted to start and just, just feeling comfortable out there, to be honest. That gave me peace. That gave me just kind of stay in the present, just keep plugging, keep plugging.

Made birdie on No., forget what hole, 6, and then I bogeyed 9 and I was a little bit like, c'mon, man, we need a good back nine, and I got it. Even though I had a couple bogeys, I made some good birdies coming in and go home with a good feeling.

**Q. What are going to be the keys tomorrow with the putter?**

**CAMILO VILLEGAS:** No, the putter's been great. Like I said, I said I missed a couple shorter ones today, but the putting was still great. I felt comfortable over the putter, I rolled some great putts and I just happened to miss two that I haven't missed in the first two days.
