Q. Justin, another high finish for you. Not the result you were looking for, but what positives can you take out of this week?

JUSTIN SUH: I mean, it was nice to play a solid round on Sunday. Overall I thought throughout the week I just hit the ball really well. Usually when I hit the ball well and have a good putting week, I can finish strong. Just overall pretty satisfied where my game's at and where it's trending. Yeah, it was just fun to be in the mix on Sunday.

Q. The 3-wood at 18 that made it into the bunker, can you just walk us through that shot and the unfortunate lie you had?

JUSTIN SUH: Yeah, the bunkers are kind of placed in -- it's an awkward number for me because driver's definitely getting into it, 3-wood has a chance of staying short. I just hit it just a little hard, probably had a pretty firm bounce. Overall I thought if it got into the bunker, if it could just get into the flat it would be OK, but it was on the downslope and I just can't get to the green from there, so pitching wedge out. Actually had a great number with the wedge, just probably caught a gust of wind. Yeah, I hit three good shots, so that's just kind of what happened.

Q. In your first full season on the PGA TOUR coming in at (indiscernible) over the next couple weeks, how do you feel like you've grown as a golfer and matured?

JUSTIN SUH: Yeah, I feel like in the beginning of the season I was trying to make cuts. In the middle I got myself into some mixes in some pretty big events. Failed, but learned a lot. And then towards the end of the season I really feel a lot more comfortable going into Sunday either holding a lead or being up there up top on the leaderboard. So I think the experience will tell and I think just putting myself in this position over and over again will give us some good chances.
