THOMAS DETRY (-14)

Q. Thomas, how would you kind of characterize the round out there for you today?

THOMAS DETRY: Very good, to be honest. Got off to a great start again, made three birdies in a row there, 4, 5, 6. You know, wish I could have made a couple more. It was tough out there. Like all the -- all the greens are sloping from back to front with soft greens and all the pins being in the back, I thought it wasn't easy to hit it close, so you definitely had to make putts. The greens are tough to putt on. I thought I managed it pretty well. Would have liked to have made birdie on the last hole, but in the end I shot a very solid 69 so I'm in position for tomorrow, which is what I was looking for.

Q. What have you learned that -- you've been in position a lot recently. What have you maybe learned that you might take into the final round that can help you possibly --

THOMAS DETRY: I felt like last week I made a couple of mistakes down the stretch at the end of my third round and I really dragged it into my fourth round. I double bogeyed 18 at Torrey on my third round. That was really -- I felt like yeah, I was still playing my fourth round with that in my mind.

We tried to work on staying in the present and be mentally stronger on all these little things which I feel like have paid off today. A couple mistakes out there, but I was really trying to stay resilient and play my game and that's it. If I play well tomorrow, I think it could be a fun day.
