Q. Seven under, Matti, today. How would you assess that round? What worked well for you out there?

MATTI SCHMID: Yeah, both rounds I hit my kind of mid and short irons really nicely, like I gave myself a lot of looks for birdie and was able to make a few of those, so that was good.

Q. Does this course suit your eye particularly? Do you see the holes well?

MATTI SCHMID: Yeah, you know, the wind is very consistent so I think you kind of get used to the lines you have to take on the tee shots. And after last year, yeah, I'm getting more and more comfortable I would say.

Q. Did you see any softness in the greens with the rains? Did that affect how you attacked the course today?

MATTI SCHMID: Soft greens always helps a PGA TOUR player I would say. That just means you can be more aggressive towards the pin, you don't have to worry about big bounces or so. Yeah, means you can be a bit more aggressive.

Q. What was your best shot you hit today?

MATTI SCHMID: Today, yeah, that putt on 7 was nice and the 3-wood I hit into 5 was also very good.
