Q. Joey, T-3, first time playing in the last group this year. What are the biggest takeaways from this weekend?

JOEY VRZICH: I need to putt better. I hit it very good, hit a lot of greens, did not make a lot of mistakes. I think I only made four bogeys this week. Hit two balls in the water today off pretty decent shots that I thought were going to be pretty good and just misjudged the wind. I just need to feel good over the putter, it was bad.

Q. What are some positives that you can take away from this weekend finishing T-3 and playing a tough golf course? What are you going to take away about the positives from your game?

JOEY VRZICH: Ball-striking is great, probably best I've hit it in a long time so I have a lot of confidence going into the green. That's a pretty big positive. Chipping's been pretty good. Yeah, just really one thing I really need to get dialed down with.

Q. Obviously played with Jose in the last group today. What were some things that you took away from his game and how he handled the course and how he handled himself throughout the final round?

JOEY VRZICH: Seems like he played here a lot, I could tell. Sets up on the tee, has a swing for every single tee, every single shot. It's like he's done it growing up his whole life. He definitely felt really comfortable being in like no matter what group he was.

Q. How impressive is it for a guy to come out here and win at the same course in a Tour-sanctioned event three years in a row?

JOEY VRZICH: Very, it's very hard to win three times in a row. It's hard to win once, but winning three times in a row is unreal.

Q. What else can you take away from these last two weeks in Mexico and take forward to the rest of the year?

JOEY VRZICH: Bring more sunscreen, it's hot. That's about it.
