STEVEN FISK (-9)

Q. (No microphone.)

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, I played really well. Putted really, really nice, didn't make anything really long other than the last hole there. Kind of hung around all day. Definitely played a little easier than yesterday, but overall really happy with how today went.

Q. Can you kind of walk me through the birdie at 9?

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, so I was kind of in between clubs on the second shot and tried to hit kind of a hard 8-iron and left it out right a bit, which was fine. Actually hit the exact same putt in the practice round from where I was and had a pretty good idea of what it was going to do. Just tried to hit a nice putt with some good speed and was lucky enough for it to go in.

Q. Now you're going into the weekend tied for the lead, that's got to feel pretty good.

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, it does. It's nice to kind of see that a lot of the hard work that I put in the last month and a half or so's paying off, because the start of the year that I had wasn't exactly what I had anticipated. Yeah, it's nice to be in a good position.

Q. When we talk about rounds in your overall professional career, where does this one stack up, because firing a 65 here is pretty special?

STEVEN FISK: You know, it's definitely up there with one of the better rounds I've played. This place is, it's not the hardest course in the world, but it can definitely be tricky with this wind and with how fast the greens are. Honestly, with how I was able to hit the ball and kind of leave myself in a lot of good positions, I made it somewhat easy again. Yeah, it was a great day.

Q. How cool is it, I don't know if you've talked to your guys, Ben and Mason, but they also are going into the weekend at 3 under. They made the cut, they might play together. How cool is it for Georgia Southern to not only be playing here at this tournament, but to represent in a really positive way?

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, I think it's awesome. With Ben being here on a sponsor exemption and Mason getting in on Monday, honestly really happy for both of them. It's nice to have three Eagles in the field, I feel like that never happens out here. So really proud of both of them. I know that they'll both play really well this weekend and it's nice for all of us to still be



here.

Q. Can you talk about the Georgia Southern contingent that was here this afternoon and evening? Your old head coach was right off the green there at 9.

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, he told me he was coming down today. He's always come down to watch me here in Savannah, so it's pretty special. He and I have a great relationship and honestly always have. We're at this point more buddies than anything else. I appreciate him coming out.

Q. So that putt on 9, I know that you made it before in a practice round. Does that give you a boost of confidence when you know you're stepping up and you're trying to sink that last shot?

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, you know, there's a little bit less that goes into trying to figure out the way it's going to break. Just kind of fall back to what I remember from a few days ago and trust what I did then.

Q. What's the distance on the putt would you say?

STEVEN FISK: 60 feet maybe, something like that. That's ballpark, yeah. Who knows, who knows.

Q. Steven, last year on Friday night you had to come back Saturday morning. What was that Friday night like and what are you going to do this Friday night tied for the lead?

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, you know, that Friday night was a little more nerve wracking. I think I was on the cut line with two holes left and laid up in the frickin' hazard on 18 the next morning to miss the cut by one, so that one stung a bit.

Honestly, that kind of propelled me to some better finishes throughout the rest of the year. Honestly, my wife came down last night, just hang out with her, hang out with my caddie a bit. I've got a great host family this week, so just kind of keep it chill.

Q. What's the host family been like? What are they cooking for dinner tonight?

STEVEN FISK: Let's see, last night was steak, chicken, mashed potatoes, green beans, so maybe I'll ask for that again.

Q. Your recipe for 7 under?

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, apparently, apparently.
