KEVIN ROY (-9)



KEVIN ROY: Yeah, it was a great way to finish. Can't beat a nice bogey-free round out here.

Q. And tied for the lead, what's your thought process now preparing for tomorrow?

KEVIN ROY: Yeah, obviously there's a lot of golf left. Yeah, going to go get a nice lunch and I think my mom and sister and brother-in-law are on their way up from Tampa. Yeah, just kind of chill out, relax, maybe head down to downtown.

Q. Tell me what was working today, just because from the start, I mean, a bogey-free round is always going to be a good one, especially on 18 when you start on the right side, but you come back and birdie. What were you feeling today?

KEVIN ROY: Yeah, no, I felt really good. I've been playing some good golf for the last month, month and a half. I've just kind of been just enjoying myself out there a lot more, been driving it really well and putting my approach shots into the right spots on the greens. My pace on the greens has been great. Yeah, just playing some really smart golf.

Q. Can you tell us about your history on this course and with this event? Have you played it before, are you used to it, and does it give you -- are you comfortable here?

KEVIN ROY: Yeah, I am comfortable here. I don't think my history here's very good, to be honest with you, but I've always liked this place. I've always liked Savannah, it's awesome, and this course is one of the better ones we play out here. So yeah, I knew I could play it, it's just kind of figuring out a good game plan to tackle this course. So far I've been able to do that.

Q. There's a lot of golf left to be played today but as it sits, tied for first going into the weekend. How's it feel to take pressure off your shoulders a little bit?

KEVIN ROY: Yeah, no, it feels great. Like I said, I've been playing pretty good, I feel very comfortable in this position. I finished second in the Bahamas, I was kind of around the lead at the Valspar a couple weeks ago. It's fun, that's why we play golf, right? Yeah, it's going to be a fun weekend and looking forward to it.

Q. Are you hoping it gets windier this afternoon?



KEVIN ROY: I don't want to wish that upon the guys, but I'm sure it's going to. I think they're calling for it. We played in gusts of 30 yesterday afternoon, so I'm sure it's going to blow a little bit, but I don't wish it upon those guys at all.

Q. Kevin, I think you skipped Argentina and Chile, right?

KEVIN ROY: I did, yeah.

Q. Obviously with this three-week break before those, but then obviously going back to February, long stretch, what have you been up to kind of killing time?
