WESLEY BRYAN (-17)

Q. Walk me through your third round. How did it feel getting the birdie on the final?

WESLEY BRYAN: The birdie at the last was nice, it was nice to see a putt drop. Felt like kind of in those -- right after -- I missed a lot of really short putts, there's really no hiding it, but I felt like right when it was starting to like teeter, I would make a nice putt and the one on the last was nice.

And so, yeah, I might go hit a few five-footers on the putting green to get ready for tomorrow, but all in all I hit the ball well. I didn't hit it great off the tee, but I felt like I managed it pretty well. Would I have liked to shoot a few better? Absolutely, but the position I'm in right now, it's a good one to be in.

Q. What was the key and kind of mindset after a bogey to kind of just bounce back?

WESLEY BRYAN: I kind of brushed the mustache and, I don't know, hopefully it offered me some thoughts of what would George do, then I did the opposite and bounced back.

I mean, there was a lot of -- I guess I made probably four, three or four bogeys today. They were all like just really dumb mistakes, like completely avoidable, so got to clean it up. Mentally stayed pretty locked in, never getting ahead of myself, never getting too upset over all the stuff that was going on. There's still a lot of golf to be played.

Q. Has George been giving any feedback the past two rounds?

WESLEY BRYAN: No. He did ship our camera guy and editor in town for today's round and tomorrow's round, so Carney's the G.O.A.T for a reason. He just hopped on a plane, came down to the Dominican. Yeah, excited to let you guys see some of the content we're going to bring from here.

Q. Is it kind of typical of your guys' relationship that kind of keep golf and competition aside on advice and just kind of there from a brother standpoint?

WESLEY BRYAN: He's offered a little more encouragement than usual, and by more than usual, the fact that I'm actually playing gives him a reason to offer a little encouragement because we're not going head to head. He was just talking over the last couple days just how comfortable the putter looks in the hands and been rolling it nice. And again, I didn't feel uncomfortable out there with it, they just didn't go in. A couple were bad putts.

But I'm excited to hear what he has to say because I think he got to watch a little bit more of



the coverage today. See what he has to say and then I'll put it in play for tomorrow.

Q. First 54-hole lead on Tour, what kind of past experiences are you going to be drawing on?

WESLEY BRYAN: Is it the first?

WESLEY BRYAN: No, it definitely wasn't RBC. Yeah, I don't know, it's fun. Excited to just get the nerves flowing a little bit tomorrow and have a chance to win a golf tournament, that's what I've wanted to do since I was 6, 7, 8 years old and got a good opportunity for that tomorrow.
