TAYLOR PENDRITH (-15)



Q. Seven under and heading into the final round, how are you feeling?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: Good. Been hitting it really nice this week. It's been super windy, so hitting a lot of like little flighted shots that I'm comfortable with. Haven't really put myself in too many difficult positions around the greens. Yeah, it's been good, been smooth. Made some putts, so that helps.

Q. Bogey-free through the past two rounds, haven't bogeyed since your second hole. What's been the key to minimizing those mistakes?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: Yeah, I feel like I haven't really had to grind for pars. Made a couple six-footers, but today like hit it really nice today. Was a little shaky early, but had some easy up-and-downs and just tried to stay patient. The downwind holes are definitely gettable. If you can hit some good drives on the into-the-wind holes and get some mid irons in, you can still make birdies there. I think the course is playing really good. It's challenging, but it's definitely scorable.

Q. How big of a factor is the wind, especially during those final holes on that stretch?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: Yeah, it's tricky. The tees are up on 14 today, so that was good to give guys a chance to go for it, but then 15, 16, 17, 18 all into the wind, you've got to hit some solid shots or the ball's going to do some crazy things. Hit some solid drives on 16 and 18 and had a good look on 18, just missed it. Overall, very happy.

Q. Putting yourself in contention, is there a number you have in mind at all for tomorrow?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: No, not really. I mean, there's still guys out there and some birdies coming in. I haven't even looked really at the leaderboard. I'm sure I'll be a few behind, but yeah, just try and enjoy it and go out there and keep doing the same stuff I've been doing.

Q. Family out here with you this week or solo?

TAYLOR PENDRITH: They're not, they're at home, solo.
