JASON DAY (-7)



Q. Jason, how would you compare yesterday's round to today's round?

JASON DAY: Three more greens definitely helps, especially with how tough the course is playing. I mean, I hit 4-iron out of the bunker on 18 just to get it to the green so that's kind of not what you're really kind of used to hitting into that green. But I think overall just managing the game pretty well around the golf course where it's tough. Like 10, for instance, you can hit it right -- I mean, obviously Patrick got up and down from that right part, but it's definitely a lot harder to get up and down than where I was down on the left side. If you can kind of position yourself -- the rough isn't high this week, so it's relatively easy chipping out of the rough and on the fairways, but you leave yourself kind of coming up the hill or not even short-siding yourself sometimes is crucial around this place.

Q. You talked last week about almost overanalyzing your swing with Chris in town. Were there any benefits out it that carried over into this week?

JASON DAY: I've had a run over the last month and a half, two months where it's just been kind of poor, hitting, I've been losing a ton of strokes to the field approach to green, not necessarily on the driver, for instance. It's weird, it's kind of strange to drive it decently well and to hit it poor coming into the greens.

But I feel like some of the stuff we're working on, I'll see like little snippets of like really good stuff. Like the last round at RBC, played really solid there. There's been like even last week I played solid on a couple days, but I just didn't have lots of opportunities. Yeah, just stay patient even though that's the hardest thing to do in golf is to stay patient.

Q. You've gotten to play the new greens for two rounds here. How do you feel those have fared over the first 36 holes and what kind of challenges do you expect to face over the weekend when they get a little firmer and faster?

JASON DAY: I think they're going to be little a little bit firmer. Well, I shouldn't say they're going to be a little bit firmer. I think they're going to be a little bit faster. We were expecting a little bit high winds today, that's no wonder they're a little bit slower. I think we're going to have really good weather on the weekend and it's going to be a little bit faster. You know, understand that we're going to have that coming in.
