TAYLOR MOORE (-6)



Q. How would you kind of describe the round today?

TAYLOR MOORE: Pretty boring, honestly, which is great out here. Yeah, did a lot of good things. Drove the ball really well, which I was happy with, and then tried to just give myself as many looks as I could.

Q. How did the course play a little differently today? Obviously it had a little bit of time to dry out?

TAYLOR MOORE: A little bit of time. It's still pretty soft out there, just so much rain earlier this week, right? So obviously ball in hand today. Maybe a little bit drier, but it still played fairly long.

Q. Other than driving the ball well, what else did you feel like you did really well today?

TAYLOR MOORE: I think when I missed, I missed in good spots, I was able to get up and down for the most part, which was a big key, kind of keep the round going, keep some momentum. So I was really happy with where we left it when I was off, and got up and down quite a bit, too.

Q. Big part of the season right now that we've been in for about a month now. Where do you feel like your game is and what you feel you might want to keep working on to hopefully continue stay in contention at the biggest events the Tour has?

TAYLOR MOORE: Sure, yeah. I think trying to score a little bit better. I feel like physically my game's been in a good spot for a while and really trying to piece four rounds together and score a little bit better in key moments. And obviously off to good start this week, so looking forward to keeping it going.

Q. What do you think you need to do to score better? Is that like -- I mean for you guys it could just be one shot a round?

TAYLOR MOORE: Yeah, honestly, it's been that simple, right? One more 12-footer goes in, one more quality look goes in, maybe one more fairway on a par-5. Really, me and my team try to zoom in a little bit, see where we could get a little bit better the last few weeks. Yeah, it's starting to work.
