MACKENZIE HUGHES (-5)



Q. Mackenzie, 5 under par, the round of the day so far, excellent play. If we can get some comments on your final round.

MACKENZIE HUGHES: Yeah, it was a great day. I mean, I didn't have the best of starts, I was 1 over through two, but kind of knew that, you know, some of those holes were playing tough so tried to kind of stay patient. I made two nice putts on back-to-back holes on 4 and 5 and that kind of kickstarted my round. I knew it was going to play tough today, but I was kind of on a bit of a roll. I tried to keep the pedal down and keep making birdies. It was just a really fun day. You don't get many rounds like this at Quail Hollow and yeah, going to take a ton of confidence from it.

Q. And today's round, sort of a snapshot of the whole week, too. Not a great start on Thursday, 2 over par but played really well the rest of the way. Just recap the week for us.

MACKENZIE HUGHES: Yeah, I walked off 18 on Thursday really frustrated with my day, felt like I played pretty good, didn't get much out of it. I got a bit better every day not just score wise but like mentally, better focus, better clarity the last few rounds.

My goal today was just to be better than I was yesterday, and not from a score standpoint but just the way I'm thinking, the way I'm going about my business. I did a really nice job of that today, so I was really proud of that.

Q. And how much does that mean, too, to have that positive outlook playing really well this weekend heading to Valhalla next week?

MACKENZIE HUGHES: Yeah, always nice to be playing well going into a major. I haven't had a ton of success at the PGA necessarily, made a couple cuts, but I haven't really contended there. I have my game trending in the right direction and obviously we'll go there with a nice boost.

Q. Nice round also with it being Mother's Day. Just talk a little bit about what your mom means to you and assuming she was probably watching today?

MACKENZIE HUGHES: Yeah, my mom, she was working till about 4:00, so I'm not sure what time it is now but she's probably just about done work, and she was probably watching on her phone the whole day.
