Q. Thirteen under through two rounds. How are you feeling?

ALISTAIR DOCHERTY: I'm feeling great. Canucks won last night and I'm feeling good with my golf game, so everything's aligning.

Q. You said earlier in the week everything was just kind of feeling right, you're much more confident. When you're out here this week, is it just playing freely? I guess what has changed in the last two weeks?

ALISTAIR DOCHERTY: I just believe in myself. I always had the doubt in my mind and I was playing very conservative. Now I'm able to trust myself and hit the shots I know I'm able to hit. Yeah, it's just belief.

Q. What specifically this week is working best for you?

ALISTAIR DOCHERTY: I mean, putter's staying hot. My short game's been saving me a little bit here and there and that kind of just keeps the flow of the round going. I haven't hit it great off the tee, but I've been in the right spots in the rough, and judging the lies for the most part pretty well. Yeah, we're putting ourselves in good spots and taking advantage at some points.

Q. How helpful has the support been that you've gotten the last couple weeks?

ALISTAIR DOCHERTY: It's amazing. I didn't really know how many people supported me, but it feels great.

Q. I was going to ask you Stanley Cup predictions, but I guess you kind of answered that already.

ALISTAIR DOCHERTY: Go canucks, baby.

Q. On 1 there, nice eagle. What was -- I guess what were you talking through there on your second shot and I guess did you hit it exactly how you wanted to?

ALISTAIR DOCHERTY: I hit it great, yeah. I blocked the tee shot really bad, but I drew a pretty good lie in the rough. There's I want to say a bird feeder in the back kind of left center of the green and that's kind of where we were aiming. The ball turned over right at the pin



and landed pretty good and ended up four feet.

Q. Even going back to amateur days, is this little stretch here the most confident you've felt in your own game?

ALISTAIR DOCHERTY: Man, that's a while ago. I mean, I had a lot of confidence in college and during the summer of junior golf and amateur golf. Yeah, I feel great now. I know I've improved in all aspects of the game, so why not now.
