**Q. Carter, now entering the final round still near the top of the leaderboard, I guess how are you feeling so far through three rounds and now with one more to play?**

**CARTER JENKINS:** Yeah, feeling good. The birdie on the last will help me sleep a little better tonight, but still work to be done. We've got 18 holes to play this golf course, anything can happen. I mean, you can make birdies on it if you're hitting great shots. You can get penalized if you miss in just the wrong spot by a yard or two.

Yeah, just going to go out there, grind away like I have the last couple of days, see what I can make happen and hopefully it goes well.

**Q. I know yesterday the course was challenging, today the scores are a little bit better. What different course conditions were there out there today?**

**CARTER JENKINS:** Less wind, for sure. Definitely by the time we got around to about our seventh or eighth hole I would say the wind laid down pretty much to where you didn't have to play (indiscernible). Pins were a little bit more accessible, a couple more pins were in some bowls, but by and large I think it might just be less foot traffic on the greens making it a little bit easier to see the lines. Ball was going a lot further today so you could have a lot shorter shots in. But yeah, more so than anything I think the pins were just a little bit softer today, a little bit more accessible.

**Q. Obviously bidding for what would be the first win on any of the different tours. Going back I guess amateur career, what was the last win or college win that you had?**

**CARTER JENKINS:** Last win that I had college wise would have been actually here in Raleigh, it was at Lonnie Poole. It was when I was at UNC Greensboro before I transferred over to Carolina, I won the event here in Raleigh. Then going back to not college I guess it would have been my last Carolinas AM, my third in a row back in 2015 at Greensboro Country Club. Maybe just got a thing for winning in North Carolina right now.

**Q. Obviously I'm sure this would be the place you would want to get the first one. How difficult is it to tune out the distractions of being back here?**

**CARTER JENKINS:** You can go one of both ways. There are moments where I feel like I



like to tune it out, sort of be in my own bubble, but then there's other moments where you've got to embrace it. It's wonderful to have all my friends come out, family, and then just the community in general come out and support me. They looked like they were having a great time out there today. Yeah, so you've got to be able to embrace the energy, have fun with it, enjoy it, laugh at it, but more so than anything just feed off of it.
