SETH REEVES (-15)

Q. Seth, another great round, carrying the lead into the weekend. A little more comfortable here at Thornblade than Carolina, I assume, after yesterday?

SETH REEVES: Yeah, but I didn't hit it as good. So in one sense I wasn't as comfortable. I like to play a fade and I hit it -- gosh, the new tee on -- this is my first time here in a couple years, so the new tee on 5 is uncomfortable. I hooked it into the trees. So then from there on my swing felt a little off all day surprisingly, but I just managed it really well. I'm putting really nicely, so that kind of made the difference.

Q. What's it going to be like for you carrying a lead into the weekend kind of after the season you've had as you kind of picked things up here the last couple weeks?

SETH REEVES: Really, my game's been trending. I've played on Tour, I know I'm good enough. It's just it's been a hard couple of years just figuring my game out. I've been working with a coach from back home, Jeff Patton, and it's really helpful. Made some adjustments and I'm actually hitting it really well. The putter -- I just needed the putter to start working and it's been doing that.

Q. If you could sum up the last couple years in like just an answer, what do you think the biggest learning experience has been for you?

SETH REEVES: Golf is hard, life's hard, but you've just got to persevere really.

It's pretty tough to get to the Tour twice and then still play poorly and really be friends with some of the best players in the world and watch them do their thing and then you kind of struggle.

Then really to be on a medical last year was pretty tough as well. Then we had -- our twins were born, so I'm kind of at home taking care of little babies while all my buddies are making birdies.

Yeah, just thankful for finally just some good play, to see some things turn around. Really, just to find kind of my game again. I've just been searching for a long time and it's nice to kind of have some conviction for that.

Q. We talked about it off camera, were you a fan of The Office, and just talk about



getting to play with --

SETH REEVES: Yeah, absolutely. I was late to The Office, but during COVID that was a show that my wife and I watched. It's so funny. Obviously Brian's super good in the show and so yeah, it's really cool to see him just as Brian, though, not as Kevin.

Just to find out he's from Atlanta like I am, so we had some common things. It was really cool. Just to play well honestly for him because he's never made the cut, so we're hoping that we can pull it out and play together tomorrow.

Q. He seemed pretty excited to go into scoring and check the score. Was he like talking about it down the stretch like today?

SETH REEVES: He wasn't -- he was trying to keep it cool, but I know his caddie, like I know it meant something to him. He was hooting and hollering after every good shot he hit, or after every birdie I made he was excited. Coming down 18 we kind of looked at each other like, hey, let's finish this off. It was really cool for me to make one for myself but for him, too. For him to just be excited to just get one more birdie to hopefully put us over the edge there.

Q. What's it like watching someone get excited like that? You talked about your own struggles, but what's it like to watch someone get really excited about something like this?

SETH REEVES: Yeah, it's what's so cool about golf is you have these celebrities that are so good in other areas of life that we kind of look up to them, but then they look up to us, they look up to us for what we do. Golf's one of those sports that so many people admire or love to play it and admire us for what we do. So it's kind of cool to see him competing, you know, versus just doing what he does as an actor or a podcast host or stuff like that. It's really cool to see the joy that golf brings people.
