JOHN PAK. (-14)

Q. John, throughout two rounds you're currently clubhouse leader after the second round. What's been working well for you out there the first two days out there on the course?

JOHN PAK: I think I've just been managing my game really well. I'm playing pretty safe and holing a lot of putts, so I'm just managing really well. I'd say that's about it, yeah.

Q. First time out at this course, what's been your thought through two rounds to see it and do you think it fits your game well?

JOHN PAK: I actually played here, I played two tournaments in junior golf and in college here, so I'm quite familiar with the course.

Yeah, I do think it fits my game pretty well. I think you've got to do everything pretty well, you can't BS your way, you've got to hit fairways and greens. It's pretty tough off the tee I thought and that's usually one of my strong suits, so I've been keeping the ball in play pretty well out here. I think it suits my game pretty well.

Q. Is there anything that's changed from what you remember last time you played here when you were in college?

JOHN PAK: Yeah, 18 was not 18. And I've had this argument with somebody for the longest time, I swear the nines were switched, but I have no idea.

Q. And just up to this point in the season you've had some strong top-25 finishes, you had the T-3 back in Savannah and some missed cuts as well. What's been your thought on your season so far to this point?

JOHN PAK: I'm pretty happy about it. I'm kind of just taking it tournament by tournament. I'm really not, like I said, putting expectations on myself, or limitations. Kind of just, I don't know, going with the flow, I guess.

Q. And just kind of as we head into the weekend now, what's kind of your thought and game plan? It's going to be a bit hotter out there the next couple days.

JOHN PAK: Oh, yeah, I saw that. Just kind of manage my game again. I think playing smart is a very essential thing on this golf course so that's what I'm going to keep trying to



do, and hopefully putts drop, we'll see.
