MAX McGREEVY (-22)



Q. Max, bogey-free 9 under today. What was working well with your game?

MAX McGREEVY: I just gave myself a lot of looks, it's kind of what you've got to do out here. Luckily, was able to make a couple putts early and just kind of feel comfortable. Found a couple things on the driving range this morning. Honestly, my swing wasn't feeling very good leading up till today, so just felt right down the line today and wasn't really worrying about missing it left or right type of thing. Just kind of freed me up and just needed to make a couple putts, and luckily, I did.

Q. You said your swing wasn't feeling good. After each round this week, though, you've been in second, right near the top of the leaderboard. What do you think that says about your game? Even though it might not be there, you're still able to find your way near the top.

MAX McGREEVY: Yeah. I mean, I still feel like I'm young out here, but kind of a vet to a lot of these guys. I think I'm starting to play like one more and that's what I'm most proud of this year so far. Just even if I haven't had my right game, I've kind of played the way that I've needed to to make sure where I'm supposed to be.

Hats off to whoever kicked me in the head finally to play the right way type of thing, but I'm just playing, I'm playing correctly. I'm giving myself looks and I'm just taking what the golf course is giving me.

Q. What is it that you found on the driving range with your swing?

MAX McGREEVY: I've had this left miss for a year and a half now. When you're trying to hit a cut and you miss it left, it does not work. It did not work on the PGA TOUR, it still hasn't been working out here.

Working with my dad and my swing coach, Tim Johnson, just kind of found a couple of things. Posture and setup's a big thing for us, if everything's right with that. I've moved maybe an inch or two farther away from the ball and gave me a little bit more freedom and allowed me to swing a little bit wider.

To be honest, it felt like I was working on my golf swing today more than I was actually like playing a tournament round, which I don't know, maybe that freed me up a little bit as well, too. Yeah, just felt good out there. It's the first time it's felt that free in a long time.



Q. Going into tomorrow with a one-stroke lead, you've been knocking at the door a lot with top-10s, just what would it mean to bring one home this year and help you get closer to that Tour card?

MAX McGREEVY: Yeah, I mean, winning's always what we want to do. The main goal out here is to get to the next stage and hopefully we can do that by the end of the year. Adding a win on the circuit at some point in the year is always what's kind of on our calendar and we're putting in our notes and stuff like that. It's going to be a shootout, this place is what it is. I'm going to play against myself and let everybody else try to catch me and just see what we can do.

Q. Does it change -- even though you play your game, does it change anything just knowing how gettable this course has been this week and the type of scores people have been putting up?

MAX McGREEVY: I told my caddie today, you know, as much as I've wanted a one-stroke lead at the end of the day, all of us are shooting for a number. I'm probably going to put together a number in the back of my head tonight and it might not be enough, and hopefully I can go lower than that number. Rather than playing each guy, I think I'm just trying to play to that number that I want to. I wish I could have shot more than 9 today, but we're all just trying to get as many as we can, as many looks as we can and yeah, we'll see how they fall tomorrow.

Q. We've been going through a long stretch here of tournaments. Where are you at physically and mentally through this long stretch? Looking forward to that break?

MAX McGREEVY: Surprisingly, today was pretty hot. Luckily it hasn't been that bad all week long. Seven weeks in a row is a lot. Luckily, I had a week at home playing, was able to stay in my own bed last week. I honestly think that just kind of rejuvenated me a little bit, my wife cooking for me all week long. Yeah, home-cooked meals are hard to come by when we're on a seven-week stretch like this, so just little things like that were really making me feel nice and rejuvenated me for this week.

Q. And you and your wife had a big announcement last week. Just can you tell us about that and how excited you are?

MAX McGREEVY: Yeah, yeah, finally she's expecting, she's pregnant. So we finally found out Tuesday of last week that we're having a little girl. So super excited, something that I know both of us have always really wanted, her especially.

It's actually been kind of fun this week kind of seeing all the little kids, especially the little girls. There was a couple playing today and probably not paying attention to the golf course; that's exactly what probably our daughter's going to be doing here in the future.



Yeah, just little perspectives like that are a lot of fun. Those are the things that just make you smile more than playing a good round of golf. That's always nice, but at the end of the year now I know that I have that to look forward to as well.

Q. What do you think you're looking forward to most as a dad?

MAX MCGREEVY: I just think it's -- to be honest, like having a girl is going to kind of change my mindset a little bit. I have a brother, I have a little nephew, I've kind of always been around guys.
