JACOB BRIDGEMAN (-9)



Q. Jacob, 1-under 70 today, if we can get some comments on your day. Way to fight back as well.

JACOB BRIDGEMAN: Yeah, I shot 1 under, I felt like anything under par today was pretty good, especially in the afternoon. We teed off I think next to last or second to last. Yeah, the wind was blowing really hard in the beginning of the round, caught a little bit of a lull at the end, which was nice. But greens were kind of bumpy from all the traffic. I was pretty pleased with 1 under. I stayed patient all day, didn't really have a whole lot of great chances.

Q. Talk us through the two bogeys there on 17 and then 1.

JACOB BRIDGEMAN: Yeah, 17 I thought was a very hard hole today. It was a really bad number for me. I wanted to hit an 8-iron but I didn't think I had quite enough, so I had to kind of chip a 7 downwind. Then I got kind of unlucky, it got up under the collar of the long cut, so whatever, it was kind of a guess on the chip down there. Thought I hit a really good putt, caught the lip. Yeah, that was just a hard hole.

And then hole 1 I drew a bad lie in the left rough, kind of hacked it out to the front and then hit a good putt up there to four-and-a-half feet. Hit a spike mark, kicked it out of the hole. So it wasn't really anything for me to be upset over, it was like the draw we got.

Q. Yeah, you didn't get discouraged, you hung in there. And then the birdies on 6 and 7, take us through those.

JACOB BRIDGEMAN: Yeah, 6, hit a little bit left off the tee, had a decent lie, laid it up, hit my wedge shot to maybe 10 feet or so and hit a good putt. I hadn't seen one go in in a while, so it was nice to get that one to go.

And 7, yeah, I just made a good 15-footer. Yeah, those two putts actually rolled well, so it was nice to see that.

Q. And just a few back, top-5 going into the weekend, how excited are you for the last two rounds?

JACOB BRIDGEMAN: Yeah, I'm looking forward to it. I haven't had a whole lot of events this year where I've been in contention. I guess the last one would probably be Honda, I guess Cognizant now. Yeah, I'm excited, I think it will be fun. I like this course, I feel I can keep up the good play and keep going.
