**Q. Stewart, what have we seen from this system since it hit the Triad area in the early morning hours?**

**STEWART WILLIAMS:** Yeah, obviously came in about 3:00 a.m. this morning and hasn't stopped raining since. We've had some real heavy rain at times and obviously some pretty strong wind gusts that's been averaging gusts 30 to 35, but we have had several 40 to 45 in the area. Definitely not a safe environment to have people out here at the golf course.

**Q. How much rain are you anticipating?**

**STEWART WILLIAMS:** Well, we've gotten three inches so far. I would think we'd probably get a couple more inches before this thing winds down overnight tonight. Still got a ways to go.

**Q. When do you expect the system to be out of the Triad and it's clear for the maintenance guys to get out there and work on the golf course?**

**STEWART WILLIAMS:** Yeah, overnight tonight Debby will move up to the north and quickly accelerate her way away from us. Could be some lingering showers first thing in the morning, but I'm anticipating the crew hopefully can get out there early tomorrow morning and get the process started of cleaning up the golf course.

**Q. And the weekend looks like what?**

**STEWART WILLIAMS:** Yeah, weekend looks a lot better. Saturday will be a mostly sunny day, mid 80s. Then a little bit cooler on Sunday, 82, slight chance of a shower or thunderstorm, but all in all, the weekend should be much better for us
