KEEGAN BRADLEY (-7)



Q. Keegan, it was in bits and pieces over the course of a few days, but you're in good condition today or I don't know when it was, but one bogey, 18 you make the turn and then birdie five of your next six holes. Just a few comments about Round 2.

KEEGAN BRADLEY: Yeah, thrilled to be done, exhausted. Played great today, it was fun. I haven't played a round like that in a while, so I'm very, very happy.

Q. OK. And then I know last year was your first time playing the Tour Championship in like five or so years. What did that mean to you and any takeaways from that going into this season?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: Well, it means everything. I think everybody's main goal to start the year is to make it to the Tour Championship because that means you've done a lot of great things. That's one of my No. 1 goals to start the year and when you do that, there's a real sense to the ending of the season. So often we're out here and the season ends and you want it to keep going. There, everybody's done and it's a good feeling.

Q. Yeah. And you're kind of in a unique position where you'll be very busy in September for the Presidents Cup, but you're playing well and if you keep peaking there could be a potential of getting a captain's pick for the Presidents Cup. Is that on your mind at all as you're going through the Playoffs?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: A little bit. I've got to go out and do something great to get on the team, which I'm trying to do. Either way, I'm looking forward to being there and helping team USA win.
