ADAM HADWIN (-7)



Q. Adam, 3 under 67, if we can get some comments on your round?

ADAM HADWIN: Yeah, pretty solid day. Drove it nicely, hit a lot of greens, had some chances. Yeah, I did a lot of really good things. I felt like I let a couple slip there on four, five holes, three-putted the par 5 and wedge in 8 and had a shorter one on 9. These greens can get pretty tricky depending on which side of the hole you're on unless you're putting uphill. Yeah, nice to be playing some good golf again.

Q. And what's been the key here? A long few days here just with all of the delays and suspensions, what's been the key for you to be playing well so far?

ADAM HADWIN: I mean, I think the biggest thing, had a week off coming in here, kind of reset the mind a little bit. I just, I think I was trying too hard. I think a lot of us talk about that sometimes, getting in our own way. I just, I wasn't -- I wasn't getting dialed into the shot at hand, I was kind of just letting my mind wander I think too much and worrying about everything and what if I do this, what if I do that kind of thing. I've done a really good job so far of getting into every shot and just one shot at a time, keep moving, keep plugging along. It's funny how that kind of works out to some good scores.

Q. You've been so consistent, this will be your tenth straight year of advancing to the Playoffs, currently projected 29th. So I know Eastlake is on your mind, but what is your mindset now with these important weeks coming up?

ADAM HADWIN: Oh, man, to keep hitting one shot at a time and seeing where it gets me, trying to do the best that I can on every single shot, no matter whether it's the first tee shot on a Thursday or the last putt on a Sunday or for eagle, for birdie, for double, doesn't matter. I think I've shown -- I've proven to myself that if I get away from that, I get into trouble. I've done a really good job, like I said, two days now of kind of focusing on that, getting into every shot, trying to have fun, trying to enjoy it.

I know there's a lot at stake these next few weeks, a trip back to Eastlake, Presidents Cup a few weeks after that. I know it's there, but I've got to try and not let my mind start to wander a little bit because I've got some bad habits with that.
