STEVE ALLAN



Q. Great playing today, 8-under total for the tournament. What was going well for you today?

STEVE ALLAN: I just was hitting the ball pretty nicely. I was really putting well. I had a couple holes on the front nine that were a little bit scrappy and saved them with nice putts for par. Then just generally it was pretty solid. I was hitting the ball crisply. I did yesterday, too, but I messed the hole up and made a triple, so it was nice to get it back going again nicely today.

Q. Did you feel like a week like this and a round like this was coming?

STEVE ALLAN: Maybe. My season was building up until the Dick's tournament. I had probably my best week there, and then it dropped off at the Firestone, British Open, and last week it was good signs, and it was better again this week. Hopefully can keep it going.

Q. What would you attribute that drop-off to?

STEVE ALLAN: I don't know. I think it was a little bit of a technical thing. My body was a little bit stiff. I don't know if it affected me or just as the season goes sometimes. It happens. Very glad to get back on to it and feel like I was striking the ball well again with the end of the season coming up.

Q. As of right now you're two strokes back. What's it going to take tomorrow?

STEVE ALLAN: I don't know. You've just got to play well. If I go out and try too hard for birdies early, it ends up in disaster, so I just try to let the round play out. We don't need to birdie the first few holes to have a good round. You can build into the round and have a hot finish, too. I'm just going to go out there and try and play well.
