Q. Grayson, great round today. Can you take us through it a little bit?

GREYSON SIGG: Just kind of keep doing what I'm doing. Golf's been pretty hard lately, so I'm just really kind of enjoying being out in the moment and just really trying to enjoy myself out there. Done a good job of that so far this week so looking forward to tomorrow.

Q. What's helping you stay in the moment?

GREYSON SIGG: I don't know. I love being in Napa, red wine's good, I guess. You know, just been steady golf. Changed a few things in my putting and been rolling in a few putts, so that's been really nice to see. Just kind of continue to do what I'm doing.

Q. Can you tell us a little bit more about what you changed in the putting?

GREYSON SIGG: Yeah. So I went to conventional grip over the last couple weeks at home. It felt a lot better at home, but obviously to kind of put it to the test these first couple days here in Napa and see some good results is promising.

Q. (Inaudible) the birdies 4 through 7 stand out?

GREYSON SIGG: Probably the one on 5. I basically hit the worst drive of the day way left and thought it might go out of bounds there for a minute. It was kind of a weird hole. I was able to kind of hit it up and over the trees and get it up and down from like a 45-yard bunker shot and made like a 12-footer, so that was pretty nice.

Q. I know it's obviously early in the fall but a nice projected bump as of right now, but of course you have to get it done tomorrow as well. Are you thinking about the Top-125 right now or is it too early?

GREYSON SIGG: Yeah, sure, it's always in the back of your head, but I can't worry about what anybody else is doing, I can just go out and try to play my best golf and stay in my own lane here. It would be easy to kind of get caught up in it, but I'm trying not to. I know what I'm doing, I know how to play good golf so I'm looking forward to tomorrow and the rest of the
