Q. So, your Tour card for next year, you're good, right?

DAVID LIPSKY: Yeah, yeah, I think so. Close to being locked up at least, way closer than I was before. It's a good feeling. It's like, you know, obviously I wanted to win this week, but coming in second doing that, I'll take it. That's a small victory and that was sort of what my goal was going into the fall was just play consistent, play solid and sort of lock up my card for the next year. Didn't the first event, so now I can play a little more freely.

Q. Looked like 70 was a pretty good score today, a lot of guys were not going much lower than that.

DAVID LIPSKY: It was really tough out there, the wind was swirling and it was strong and the greens were so firm. Where they put some of those pins is really tough to get close. My iron play was really good in spots, so it was a little bit more stress free I'd say.

Q. And you actually had a hot start, you were 2 under through four to put a little bit of heat on him, so you at least made it interesting for a while.

DAVID LIPSKY: I think I was 3 under through six. There's a couple holes I didn't hit great shots off the tee. That's what happens out here when it plays this firm and fast. The rough's up, you can get into trouble quick.

Q. Does this change your scheduling at all? Like you don't have to probably play all of them anymore.

DAVID LIPSKY: I'm a golf sicko, I'm probably going to play everything.

Q. This is your best finish of your professional career here on the PGA TOUR. Can you talk about what it means just to finish like you did and then lock up the card hopefully for the rest of the year?

DAVID LIPSKY: Yeah, I'm in a good spot to keep my card. It is where I've always dreamed of playing. I was pretty depressed through the middle of the season with my game and I couldn't be happier right now, it means the world to me.

Q. I talked to Pat Goss today. It was like you and the other guy were like on the team almost.

DAVID LIPSKY: Oh, yeah.

Q. Doing the dinners and everything.

DAVID LIPSKY: Yeah, exactly.

Q. So that paid off.
