**LEE JANZEN (-6)**



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**Q. Nice move today. How important is it for you to play next week?**

**LEE JANZEN:** Well, now that I'm close, I guess I should say it's somewhat important, but I barely got in this week. I played decent in Jacksonville, in the second last group, so there's signs that I can play better than I have. I played decent in Michigan and struggled at Bay -- at (indiscernible) to make birdies. But that can happen to anybody.

I feel like my game is probably better now than it has been all year. We all struggle with certain injuries or whatever and I, you know, tried to stay ahead of it for 25-plus years. This year I've got something new, so hopefully whenever the season does end, I'm going to have a couple months to work on my body and hopefully get it in better shape and play next year and a few more years. That's what I hope for.

But it's going to come to an end someday and you have to accept it and be happy about it. I'm grateful I've gotten to play as long as I have. A lot of guys haven't got that opportunity because of injuries. Even if I have to battle through that, I don't care, I've gotten to play a lot of golf. A few more years, I can get to a thousand events and that would be awesome.

**Q. How close are you?**

**LEE JANZEN:** I think I need five more pretty full years to get there.

**Q. And what's the injuries? No operations, right?**

**LEE JANZEN:** I haven't had any operations up to now and I hope I don't have to get one.

**Q. What are we dealing with?**

**LEE JANZEN:** What's that?

**Q. What are you dealing with?**

**LEE JANZEN:** Well, this year the thing that popped up in July, started feeling something in my right arm. Never had that. Recent MRI shows bulging disks, multiple, stenosis, and a narrowing that's pinching a nerve that's decreasing the strength in my right arm. I could use some traction and exercises. If that does it, that's great. If it doesn't, then I've got it make another choice.

**Q. Let's hope it does it.**

**LEE JANZEN:** Yeah. I know doctors are great at that sort of thing. I certainly wouldn't do it unless the risk was very low and the reward was very high.
