**BRETT QUIGLEY (-5)**



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**Q. What does this leave you for the future?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** A big question mark. Actually, you know, most importantly my health. I've been struggling with a labrum tear the last three, four months, so trying to sort that out, trying to figure out if it's a good decision to get surgery, good decision to get PRP, stem cells, where to do that. There's a lot of unknowns.

I'm relieved that the season's over. It's been a lot of physical and mental anguish. Hopefully toughen me up for next year. And I'll sharpen my pencil, I might be emailing a lot of exemption letters.

**Q. Is Q-School a thought?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** Yes, depends on what I do with my hip. If I do PRP or stem cell, probably. If I do surgery, I think it's a pretty extensive couple months off, so probably not. Ultimately be ready for Hualalai if that's the perfect world and see how it goes from there. Next couple weeks should determine a lot of it. I'll go from there.

**Q. How crazy is this tour where you can go from one year winning to this being outside?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** I mean, that's a testament of how good these guys are and if you don't have great status, you've got to play well every year. I had a super year last year and did not perform well at the beginning of the year, then got hurt halfway through. It was kind of a double whammy, but I'm strong enough to come back from this. I will be back no matter what.

**Q. Building off that, your win last year, the confidence, everything, do you still feel like your game's in a good spot despite the injuries?**

**BRETT QUIGLEY:** Yes. It's difficult when you're hurt, you can't practice as much as you want to. I still could play okay, but not being mentally, physically prepared is the difference out here. Three or four shots each week is massive on having a chance to win and the money list.
