**KEN DUKE**



**KEN DUKE:** I mean, I played OK. Just never got anything going yesterday, but today was a little bit better. Still just didn't make very many putts. A lot of good shots, just never got the speed of them. A lot of great fans out there again. It's really nice.

**Q. Ten and 11, you had it going.**

**KEN DUKE:** Well, they're a little easier holes, but I hit some good shots. Get it going when you have a couple easy holes and hit some good shots. I hit a good shot on 12, hit a good shot on 13. Then 14, 15 we didn't play well, caught the rain. Just kind of gave one back on 18.

No, it's been a great week. I can't look back on it, I wouldn't have done anything different than I've done. Glad I'm going to Arizona. That was our whole goal was to get here and get there to Arizona, that's what we were looking for.

**Q. I was going to say the battle is here, but the war is getting there, I guess?**

**KEN DUKE:** Yes, it is. I'm sure everybody's pulling for me, I appreciate that. I've only won one time out here in five years and I won one time on the PGA TOUR in 15 years. It's hard to win, but it's great to be out here to compete.

**Q. How long was your putt on 17?**

**KEN DUKE:** Twenty-footer or something like that in the pouring rain.

**Q. And who did you give the putter bump to?**

**KEN DUKE:** Rocco. He hit it like this far, he hit it close. No, it was pumping down rain when we played there.

**Q. I was going to ask you, not to -- everybody's kind of played in it, but for you and how you hit the ball, you need a little runout there. How much of a problem --**

**KEN DUKE:** It's not really a problem. I had it yesterday and just didn't score. That's the thing about here, you've got to score. I'm glad it did rain today because everyone saw the golf course really firm and fast and they saw it a little bit differently. Totally different wind, south wind yesterday and north today. They'll be back. I think the hospitality is getting everybody and they like the golf course. That's the main thing when guys come play.

**Q. Finally, what was your Cup finish last year?**

**KEN DUKE:** 22, 23, 21, something like that, yeah.

**Q. But again, the goal --**

**KEN DUKE:** Yeah, that's the goal. I mean, I pinch myself even being out here to win this thing. You have to win four or five times to win the Charles Schwab Cup and I don't have the (indiscernible) these guys have and the career these guys have, but I've had a good career over the last 20 years. It's been really nice.
