NICO ECHAVARRIA (-20)



Q. Nico, you began the day with a two-shot lead, looked extremely calm all day. How were the nerves?

NICO ECHAVARRIA: They were fine. I managed it well. I took a lot from that and just kept myself calm. It was very fun, that was a lot of fun with these two guys battling it out and here we go.

Q. You when you won in Puerto Rico, you said the win proved to yourself that you were better than what you thought. What does this second one do?

NICO ECHAVARRIA: I was very nervous starting, but I managed it well. I made a lot of key putts out there. I only had one bad swing all day. Other than that I played a lot of good golf, so I'm happy to finish the way I did.

Q. You led the field in putting this week. Anything change from the week prior?

NICO ECHAVARRIA: New grip this week, that was the difference. Yeah, I consider myself a good putter, I just needed something different. These greens are rolling so good that it wasn't very hard to make a lot of putts.

Q. How are you going to celebrate your win tonight?

NICO ECHAVARRIA: I don't know. I didn't get much to celebrate in Puerto Rico, I think we're going to go a little stronger tonight and enjoy it here in Japan
