And I also just love match play. I feel like I can be more aggressive and I just felt pretty confident the whole day. It was kind of a close match on the back nine, so I think I did a good job of kind of staying patient and trying to be committed.

Q. What's it mean to play on a golf course with such historical awesomeness as East Lake?

CAROLINE CANALES: Honestly, it's unreal. I mean, our team has been looking forward to this ever since the National Championship and we knew we would be invited for getting semifinalists. It's crazy to think that we get to play the same course as the PGA TOUR guys, it's just so surreal and we're really grateful to be here.

Q. What's prep look like tonight for tomorrow?

CAROLINE CANALES: I think a little bit of the same. I'm going to work on some drives, maybe some wedge shots for some target practice, but I think we're going to keep it pretty minimal, get some good rest and look forward to tomorrow
