**Q. You made a few today.**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** He's a prophet, I guess.

**BERNHARD LANGER:** It's unbelievable, I can't describe it. To win this big tournament after what I've been through and to make it 17, maybe 18 years in a row out here because I won when I only played five tournaments, it's quite amazing.
