ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART (-6)



Q. Great round, that was terrific. You had the T-3 last week, which you referenced, and off to a roaring start this week. How would you kind of assess how this year has gone?

ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART: I mean, it's been lots of learning this year, I'd say. You know, I'm glad it's working out. A little late maybe, but being a rookie, you get to play a new course every week. That's not easy. I made some changes early in the year, which was a little tough at first, especially when it came to my confidence. To know that I finished in the top 3 last week definitely gave me a boost and coming out today and shooting a 6 under round is pretty solid in this wind.

Q. What did you need to learn to turn it around the way you have the last two weeks?

ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART: For me personally, it's more like keeping the ball in play. If I can do that off the tee, that's going to be a huge deal. I just feel like grinding around the greens, that's something I haven't been doing very well this year, just not getting the momentum going. Today I've been able to do a really good job at that. I think that comes just from practicing the right way as well.

Q. Do you have anybody here this week like coaches, friends and family?

ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART: I've got my girlfriend with me, but no, besides that, I don't have any coaches with me.

Q. With this being the last week of the FedExCup Fall with everything that is at stake, how do you balance that and being able to focus on the round that you're on?

ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART: I feel like, it's weird to say but I don't have much to lose right now besides trying to do my best to win this tournament. Finishing top 3 last week definitely helped my FedExCup standing and I know that probably a top 2, top 3 this week could do it to keep my card. I just have to play solid golf, keep the pedal down and see what that brings me.
