PATRICK FISHBURN (-11)



Q. Patrick, what a round today from you, seemed like you were playing a different golf course. Just what were the highlights for you today?

PATRICK FISHBURN: Yeah, thanks. Got off to a really good start, hit one close on the first hole. I've had a lot of experience playing in cold growing up in Utah, playing this time of year, kind of get used to playing when the body's not moving very well and you've got to move your hands. Just pretty happy with how I played, kind of stayed in the moment mentally, one shot at a time. Just kept the ball in play and that was kind of the key. Once you get the ball in play, you can kind of attack. Made a few putts and hit some good iron shots, did everything pretty well, pretty happy with it.

Q. Career low 9 for you on the front nine today. Did you know that that was coming when you were warming up today?

PATRICK FISHBURN: You never know what golf's going to bring. You could shoot 45 or 35 or 29, you never know what it's going to bring. I kind of, like I said, I got off to a good start, hit it really close on the first hole, then had a good look on the second hole, just kind of kept the momentum going. Made a nice eagle on 8, two really good shots in there to about six feet. And then 9 was pretty lucky, I was kind of just left of the green a little bit in the fringe and ball was planning to go six feet by but hit the hole and went in, so that was pretty lucky.

Q. You've been playing great this FedExCup Fall. How do you kind of explain that surge in your game in the final stretch?

PATRICK FISHBURN: Yeah, just getting more and more comfortable as the year goes on. Rookie season, everything's new to me, so I'm getting more comfortable with the way the courses are and how the setups are. I feel like my game historically, I've started off really slow and then kind of gets better as the season goes on, so a little bit of that.

But just the ball-striking's been pretty consistent, starting to putt it a little more consistent. The game's in a good spot right now.

Q. And you're in a good position in the FedExCup, but a win or top finish here does a lot, obviously with a win or even moving into numbers 51 through 60 for the Aon Next 10, are you thinking about those things?

PATRICK FISHBURN: For sure, yeah. There's so much to play for every single week and a win is career changing, life changing. You're always thinking about that.

But taking it back and trying to break it down to one shot at a time and sticking to the process and doing your routine, just sticking to all those things. Yeah, that's always in the back of your mind, but you can control what you can control and prepare the same way every day and hopefully good outcomes happen.
