STEVEN FISK (-5)



Q. Steven, it's your first PGA TOUR start, making the cut. What a great round today. What's your takeaway?

STEVEN FISK: Today was a lot better than yesterday. Got off to a bit of a slow start yesterday and just kind of hung in there, tried to get myself close enough to have a good chance going into the weekend. You know, got hot kind of around the time making the turn today to get well inside the cutline, I guess. Then just tried to keep it going.

Q. Can you talk to us a little bit about that birdie roll that you had going as you made the turn?

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, it's funny, the birdie putt I had on 16 that kind of got it all started, I hit that exact same putt in the practice round so was able to execute that one. Then hit a couple wedge shots pretty close and as easy as five birdies in a row can be was pretty much what it was.

Q. Having won just up the road in Savannah, you must like the geography of the area. Talk a little bit about the golf courses here.

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, I love the greens, I love fast greens. It's kind of the same thing we had in Savannah this year. A little bit of wind is a challenge, but I feel like something you can embrace and try to get it going when maybe some other guys are having some issues. Certainly can separate a field pretty quickly when it's blowing as hard as it is.

Q. Earlier this week you weren't sure how many people would be out following. How has the turnout been for you? Is it low key or do you have a good following here?

STEVEN FISK: I would say just right. Not too many, but a lot of the people that have supported me for a long time made the trip down and very nice of all of them.
