**KEVIN YU ( -8)**



**Q. Kevin, how would you assess your play overall today and this week?**

**KEVIN YU:** It's been good. I mean, I feel like today I had a lot of chances, just didn't make anything on the green today, but I feel like everything was pretty solid. Then yeah, looking forward to tomorrow.

**KEVIN YU:** Not much, honestly. Just really I think me and my parents went to like a Japanese restaurant and didn't do much. Hopefully when I go back to Taiwan we can do a little more, but right now didn't do much.
