I felt like I had so many either irons or around the green in good spots and made pars. You can get away with it a day, maybe two, but over the course of a week it's just going to catch up to me and it did.

Q. How much enthusiasm do you have -- I know you have a few weeks home to rest, be with the family. How much enthusiasm do you have for the start of next season?

JUSTIN THOMAS: I'm very excited. Yeah, I feel very, very close, I just need to sharpen some things up. Just need to kind of get the scoring clubs a little bit sharper and better. I feel like my mid irons and iron game is close to where I want it, but if I can just get those wedges back where I feel like they should be and how they are for me, I feel like things will be good.
