**Q. Great round, hold the lead right now. Can you just walk us through some of the highlights of the day today, especially the finish on 18 there?**

**HANK LEBIODA:** Yeah, it was a nice, probably a good break to be honest with you on 18, hit out of the bunker onto the green, made the putt. Yeah, played really nicely today, kept it clean. I think I only missed two fairways, missed two greens. Round was really simple to be honest with you. It was nice to have fresh greens this morning to putt on.

**Q. Hit a lot of them close, made a lot of putts. What was the summary today?**

**HANK LEBIODA:** Yeah, I wasn't really making anything that would be unusual as far as length of putts or anything like that. Fortunate if you hit it in the fairway, you get quite a few wedges to the greens and I was hitting my wedges really nice.

**Q. New course for everyone. What have you made of the course and then the resort amenities here this week?**

**HANK LEBIODA:** Happy to be here at Atlantis. Easy trip down, very welcoming. Hopefully be coming back here.

**Q. You've been on Tour the last I think it's a handful of years. How have you viewed having to come back down here, earning your way back up to the Tour this year?**

**HANK LEBIODA:** It's all competition. Wherever you are able to play, you've got to go and compete. Fortunately here for the Korn Ferry Tour and I think part of what Alex has done to kind of promote the Tour, a lot of good players are here now, a lot more PGA TOUR players are playing, fields are going to get better and like I said, it's just going to be more competition.

**Q. Is there something in particular that you're working on in your game trying to just sharpen, like any particular aspect that's going to get you back to the Tour?**

**HANK LEBIODA:** No. It's not just one thing that will get you back to the best job in the world, it takes a lot of work. It takes a lot of different areas being sharp and good. Just the more you stay on top of it, the more you're honest with yourself and your assessments and how you go about your work, the easier the path will be for you.



**Q. What do you think is the biggest thing you learned from your time on Tour that you're going to bring here into the season as you try to get back?**

**HANK LEBIODA:** You learn a lot about your game, learn about yourself. I was 24 I think when I got my card. I was young. Playing rounds with guys that had been on Tour for that many years, it's crazy to say but it's true. Look at somebody like Stewart Cink who I had the opportunity to play practice rounds with in tournaments. There's just so much to learn, so much to understand about the game and about your game specifically. The more you're able to play, the more you're able to compete, the more you get it know yourself.

**Q. Anything fun in the offseason that you were able to get into?**

**HANK LEBIODA:** I got to be dad to my two little boys. Home for three months straight, it was special, really nice. It's not something we usually get to do as professional golfers. It was a really, really nice time.

**Q. Did you do anything in particular, take 'em on a big trip or anything?**

**HANK LEBIODA:** No, we did Disney, hit the Mouse House early on in the offseason. Spent time with family and that was it. Just simple.
