**Q. Davis, 9 under, bogey free today. Started off with four straight birdies. I guess talk us through the start of the day and how you kept that rolling.**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, I hit it close. I started on 10, hit it to three feet, so it was obviously a really nice start. And then yeah, from there I just kept hitting it close and made it really easy on myself. Yeah, hit a lot of fairways today and then just gave myself a lot of looks. I was happy with how I ended it.

**Q. We talked yesterday about kind of the crosswinds out here. Were you dealing with that again today or was the course playing different out there?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, it was definitely playing much different. We had the opposite wind today and then it was really not blowing. We were kind of playing in a dome out there. This course obviously, you can look at the scores, it plays a little bit different when it's not windy. Yeah, just lucky to get it done today.

**Q. We talked yesterday about you're trying to keep your foot on the gas going in the weekends more this year. How do you kind of go about that?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, I think my first year I was just really happy when I would make the weekend and then you end up with a couple points. So yeah, you've got to look at it as every new day is a new day, you've got to take it one step at a time. I think as the time goes on, I get more experience, I get better at that, I'm not all the way there, but this weekend I'm just going to take it one shot at a time and whatever it ends up being at the end of the week is what it is.

**Q. I was talking to your caddie a little bit while you were in scoring, he said you guys were talking about Notre Dame-Ohio State a little bit to keep it light out there. What specifically were you talking about that and how do you keep kind of that light feeling going into the weekend after the game?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** I think eight and a half point underdogs is kind of disrespectful, to be honest with you. No, but I think they'll put up a good fight regardless of how it goes. Yeah, having Luke talk about stuff not golf related obviously keeps it super light and yeah, I'm grateful to have him.



**Q. Is that always what you try and do out on the course, talk about other stuff outside of golf?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, for sure. You're out there for five plus hours and you only hit shots for a total of five, six minutes. There's a lot of time to yourself and if you have a caddie that understands that, then that's a great thing.
