DANNY WALKER (-5)

Q. Danny, 2 over today. I just want to talk to you about the round and how it went out there.

DANNY WALKER: Yeah, just a crazy day, for sure. One of those days where you can't even think about what you're shooting, just got to do your best to hit every shot and just accept whatever happens. So much of where the ball's going to go is just out of your control. Did my best to just keep a level head and just take it one shot at a time. It's all you could do.

Q. Talk to me about those conditions. I mean, the winds were just uncontrollable.

DANNY WALKER: Right. What made it really hard is usually when it's that windy, it's kind of constant but it was just super gusty, so at times it would lay down and then it would pick up, so you just didn't really know what you were going to get when you hit the shot. You just have to be a little bit more conservative for that reason.

Q. Were there any club adjustments you had to make, any yardages that really stuck out to you?

DANNY WALKER: Probably the hardest one over on the North course was like 12, the par 3, because it was blowing like 30 into and you just can't come up short. Almost was going to hit 7-wood from like 195 or something, but hit 4-iron and it laid down, went over the green. It was just a crazy day.

Q. Have you ever had to make adjustments like that before?

DANNY WALKER: The only thing I can compare it to is maybe playing in the Bahamas. Usually there it's really consistently strong winds so you don't really have to have like two clubs on hand like depending on what the wind does, right? It's hard for me to think of anything else to quite compare to that today.

Q. Danny, how challenging is it mentally when you go bogey free yesterday on a really difficult course in good conditions to then come out and play a course that's so-called a little bit easier --

DANNY WALKER: Right.

Q. -- but with a lot of wind? You make one par on the inward nine. How challenging is it to adjust to that?



DANNY WALKER: Yeah, it's always super hard. I think today in some ways it almost made it easier because I knew it was playing so hard. Like I made a few bogeys in a row, like I'm doing everything right, I don't need to worry, it's going to happen out there today. I had to be so focused on each shot I couldn't really think about anything else because it was so difficult. That almost kind of helped, I think.

Q. You're standing here at 5 under, leaders still got three, four holes to go at 6 under. What do you think your chances are of being in the tournament lead at the end of the day with a couple holes still to play?

DANNY WALKER: I think probably not. These guys are good. If that's the case, then great. Either way, I'm happy with the position I'm in going into Friday.

Q. How satisfying is it to make your first cut on the PGA TOUR?

DANNY WALKER: Yeah, very, especially being up there near the lead, it makes it that much better. Good to get that monkey off my back a little bit.
