Q. Solid couple rounds, put yourself in contention there heading into the final day. Just what do you like about your game this week?

WESLEY BRYAN: Well, there wasn't really much to like today other than the chipping and putting. Hit it pretty terrible, drove it bad, but I did leave myself in some reasonable situations and it was just damage control all day long. So don't really know what we've got to fix to get in the tournament tomorrow, but we'll wake up and see what tomorrow's offering.

Q. Can you take me three that 17th hole, kind of that save you made from way --

WESLEY BRYAN: Yeah, I feel like those are the situations where like it's so tough to keep like the integrity of the game and sprinkler heads and yardages and all that stuff and walking where a laser would have sped that up.

I felt bad kind of icing Harris right there and walking 170 yards up to the green and back and making sure the numbers were all right. But again, it was a big moment and trying to keep a little bit of momentum on what was a real scrambly day.

I got a really favorable drop, I had a clear shot, great angle, clean lie and was able to hit it on the green and two putt.

Q. One of our social cameras said they had kind of a funny interaction with you and the fans there, if you recall it?

WESLEY BRYAN: Yeah, there was probably a thousand of those today. I don't know, the support out here's been amazing and the things people say, it definitely makes me chuckle. And I'm definitely not one of those athletes -- sorry, golfer, not athlete, but they say they don't really hear much out in the crowd. I hear it all and I love it.

Q. Just finally, close to your card of the Top-125 last year, you're playing some really good golf and carrying it at least through this week. Anything in particular that you feel like in the last five, six months has really clicked or a reason behind it?

WESLEY BRYAN: I mean, I have been, and I know the stats aren't going to show it today, but I'm definitely more confident off the tee and driving it a lot better.

Again, today was just hit and hope type of day, but consistently been getting the ball in play and hitting it a little longer, which helps. Been starting to make more putts, which obviously helps.

Then there's like a little bit of freedom that I've been playing with knowing that kind of my playing time on the Tour is for sure coming to an end at some point and then kind of the trajectory of the YouTube, which is going great. I've kind of found a new passion and love for the game in a way I never saw coming.

So yeah, I'm enjoying where I'm at, not taking any of these opportunities for granted and kind of putting my head down and going to work on the YouTube front and loving that. There's definitely like a better mindset that I've had with the game over the last probably now year and a half, two years.
